Community Updates: We've been busy making improvements around the neighborhood! Here are a few projects that have been completed so far this year:

- Cleanup project around Landfall Lake. The area was cleared of overgrown vegetation and debris improving the appearance around the entire lake.
- Indigo Pond was cleaned up with mowing around, dead tree removal and mulching of underbrush.
- June 18th – 2 drains on Indigo Drive will be jetted out and debris from basins removed to clean lines to holding pond.
- Installed a drain grate at Landfall Lake.
- Removed remaining portions of the HOA fence on Bertha.
- The updated ACC Charter and Landscaping Contract have been posted to the HOA website. We encourage all homeowners to review the documents at your convenience. If you have any questions, feel free to reach out to the board.
- The HOA has provided a grill at the gazebo for all homeowners to use! It's a great spot for casual cookouts, family meals, or just enjoying a summer evening with neighbors. Please remember to clean up after use so everyone can enjoy it!"
- Landfall Roads - As discussed during the Landfall Annual Meeting in April we are now in the window for another Sealcoat treatment of our Roads. However, with two houses currently under construction and one house about to begin construction, we will wait until those projects are complete before the Sealcoat treatment begins. The current estimated Sealcoat start date is the Fall of 2026. A detailed Sealcoat plan will be promulgated before the work commences. For questions, call Dan McCort.
